IDANG Voluntary AGR Tour Curtailment Requests

<u>Use</u> – AGRs may use this form in conjunction with an AGR orders request form to request an early release from their AGR tour based on a personal hardship or other valid reason. Typically, AGRs might request an earlier tour end date to align with career changes such as resignation, retirement, transfer, ADOS/STAT or other employment opportunities.

<u>Ruleset</u> – Normally AGR members must serve 24 months of their current assignment and complete their applicable service commitments before early release is approved. Airmen who voluntarily request separation from AGR status are not entitled to separation pay. This includes Airmen who voluntarily accept a military technician position. AGR members who later request withdrawal of the curtailment action must have approval to withdraw the curtailment from the final command signatory for the action.

<u>Initiator</u> – Requesting AGR

<u>Routing Process</u> – Member, Unit/Group CC, FSS, FW/CC, IDANG/CC or TAG if applicable. Air AGR Manager will process only with both an approved curtailment request and AGR Orders Request form.

<u>Timeline</u> – Approval no later than 60-90 days prior to requested tour end date is the optimal timeline for these requests.
