Job Description

Idaho Power is seeking a Business Applications Specialist (also called Application Development Analyst) to work in the Power Supply Technical Applications group, supporting the electrical transmission operations area. This position provides support for the Load Serving Operations department by administering and monitoring information systems and developing solutions for energy and transmission, generation and balancing.

The successful candidate will work collaboratively in a complex regulatory environment with technological applications, and must recognize and maintain transmission business processes consistent with Federal and State regulations and current industry requirements. Will also ensure compliance with FERC, NERC, and regional policies and practices.
