

<u>YOU HAVEA RIGHT TO FILEA COMPLAINT OF DISCRIMINATION</u>



Authority: NGR 600-22/ANGI 36-3

If you are a **National Guard Military member, AGR (Title 32 USC), or an applicant for membership** and you feel you have been discriminated against due to race, color, religion, gender (including sexual harassment), national origin, or retaliation (based on EO activity) you must file within 180 days...

They will provide advice and try an informal resolution of the complaint. If not resolved you may follow step 2.	File a formal written complaint with the unit commander, EOA/MEO staff or a higher level chain of command.	The Commander will cause an inquiry and attempt resolution within 60 days of receipt of complaint.	If not satisfied with resolution you have 30 days to indicate in writing your desire to pursue complaint at the next level of command.

Inquiry/Investigation			
Upon your request to pursue, each intermediate level commander will have 30 days to inquire or investigate the complaint and attempt resolution.	Upon your notification to pursue the complaint, the Adjutant General may attempt to resolve or direct a formal investigation within 90 days.	After investigation you will receive a copy of the Report of Investigation. The AG or designee will meet with you to attempt resolution.	If complaint is not resolved, the AG will request NGB to issue a final decision. Upon NGB's decision there are no further appeals.
